Canfax reported Saskatchewan feeder cattle volumes at 10,266 head sold over the week, down from 14,068 head reported the previous week. This is below the 14,002 head marketed during the same week last year. Year-to-date, feeder cattle marketing's are 14 per cent below 2022.


Saskatchewan feeder steer prices were above the previous week amongst all weight categories reported on February 10. Prices ranged from \$338.67 per cwt for the 300-400lb weight category to \$237.05 per cwt for the 900+lb weight category. The largest price increase was steers in the 400-500lb weight category which were up an average of \$6.41 per cwt.


The average weekly prices for Saskatchewan's feeder heifers were also higher and reported in all weight categories for the week of February 10. Prices ranged from \$269.00 per cwt for the 300-400lb weight category to \$216.63 per cwt for the 800+lb weight category. The 300-400lb weight category had the largest price increase of \$10.62 per cwt compared to the previous week.

The Saskatchewan 750 lb. feeder steer basis compared to the February 9, 2023, U.S. feeder cattle index at US\$183.09 cwt was calculated at (+\$17.99) per cwt (\$262.63-US\$183.09/0.7484) strengthening by \$1.76 per cwt from the basis of (+\$16.23) per cwt the previous week. The basis is \$27.82 per cwt stronger than it was the same week a year ago when it was (-\$9.83) per cwt.

The March feeder cattle futures were up US\$0.300 per cwt last week to settle Friday at US\$186.400 per cwt. The April 2023 contract was up slightly (US\$0.050 per cwt), week-over-week, to settle Friday at US\$190.675 per cwt.

The February live cattle futures contract price was up US\$0.925 per cwt over the week to settle Friday at US\$161.200 per cwt. The April contract for live cattle was down slightly (US\$0.175 per cwt) from the previous week and settled Friday at US\$163.950 per cwt.

Prices of live, non-fed cattle in Alberta reported on February 10 were up compared to February 3. The price of D2 slaughter cows increased \$2.17 per cwt from the week prior to average \$104.07 per cwt. The price of D3 slaughter cows were up 2.36 per cwt to average \$89.67 per cwt. The rail price for non-fed cattle in Alberta ranged between \$200.00-205.00 per cwt, unchanged from the previous week.

The Canfax price for Alberta fed steers reported on February 10 was \$194.10 per cwt. This was up \$2.49 per cwt compared to the last reporting of \$191.61 per cwt on February 3.

The live (FOB feedlot) weighted average 5-area (Texas/Oklahoma/New Mexico, Kansas, Nebraska, Colorado, and Iowa/Minnesota) weekly fed steer price in the U.S. was reported at US\$158.98 per cwt, up 0.5 per cent compared to the previous weeks price of US\$158.17 per cwt.

The dressed (delivered basis) price for U.S. steers delivered to plants in the 5-area was reported at US\$253.90 per cwt, up 1.6 per cent from US\$249.88 per cwt the previous week.

Choice beef cutout prices (600-900lb.) for the week averaged US\$267.89 per cwt, up 0.8 per cent from US\$265.82 per cwt the previous week. The choice beef cutout price was 3.0 per cent below the same week a year ago when it averaged US\$276.31 per cwt.

U.S. beef production for the week ending February 10, 2023, was estimated at 519.70 million lb., down 1.8 per cent from the previous week and down 7.6 per cent compared to the same week in 2022.
